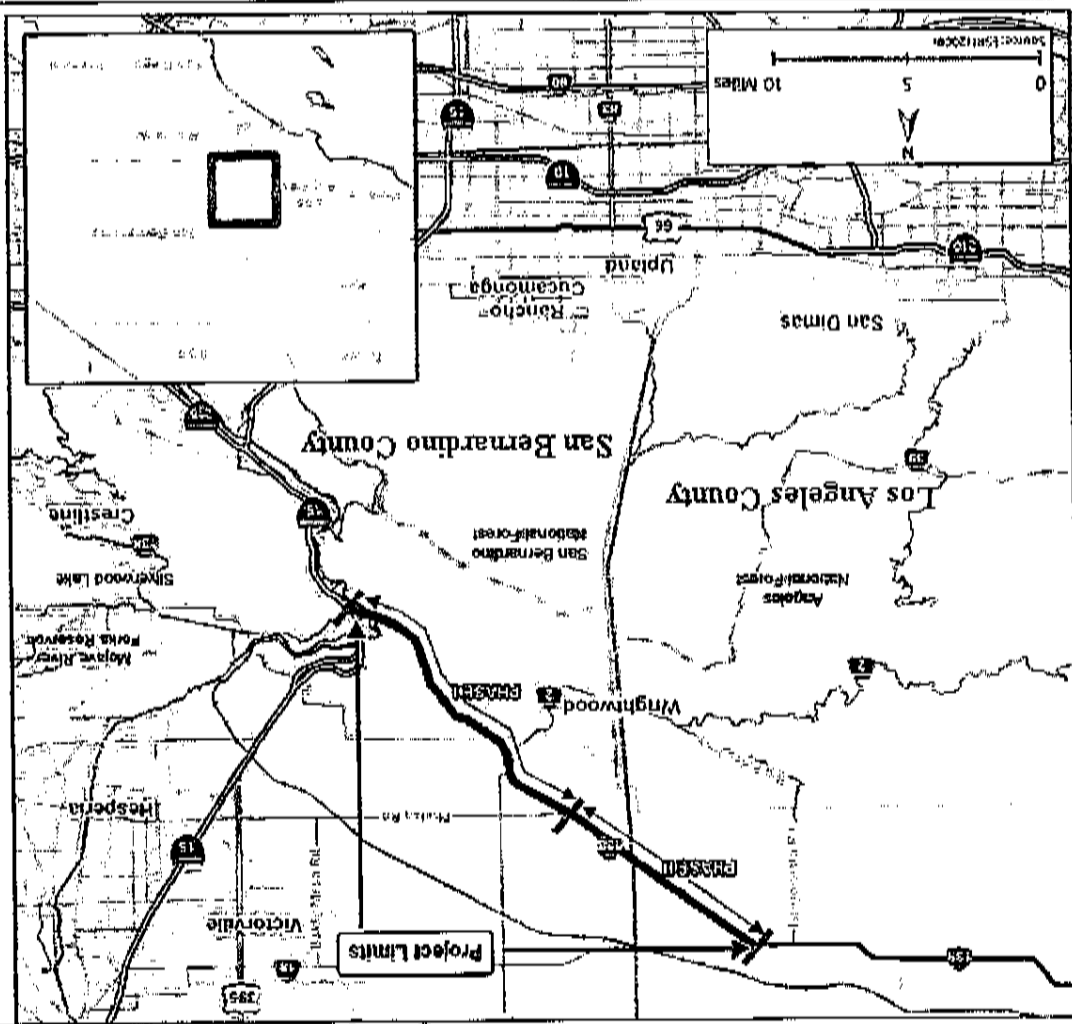

<p>WHY THIS AD</p> <p>Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. The results are detailed in a Draft Initial Study (proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration)/Environmental Assessment Document. This notice is to advise of the availability of this document for review and comments. This notice also serves as notification and an opportunity to comment on the project's Air Quality Conformity Analysis. The project meets the Regional transportation conformity requirements. Furthermore, this project will have no negative impacts to localized CO concentrations and is not considered a Project of Air Quality concern regarding particulate matter (PM10 and PM2.5) as defined in 40 CFR 93.123(b)(1). This notice is also to notify you that an Open Forum Public Hearing will be held on the proposed project on April 6, 2010 between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm at Pinon Mesa Middle School, 9298 Sheep Creek Rd, Phelan, CA 92371. This meeting will give you an opportunity to provide comments and discuss the features of the project with Caltrans staff, and record your comments with a court reporter.</p>	
<p>WHAT'S BEING PLANNED</p> <p>The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to widen State Route (SR) 138 from 2-lanes to 4-lanes with 4 feet median buffer and realign portions of the mainline. The project limits begin in Los Angeles County at SR18, PM 69.4 to PM 74.9 and in San Bernardino County from PM 0.0 ending at I-15 at PM R15.2.</p>
